

This change allows us to utilize the upright piano in a space for **choir** to practice. The **men's group** had an inaugural meeting and look forward to planning the next. All families have enjoyed our new monthly **Family Fellowship Nights**.

What's new in January? We'll begin with a 24-hour prayer marathon; marionsalemchurch.org/DearGod24 is the sign-up page or contact me. We'll begin inviting the children to remain in worship with us on the first Sunday of each month, so they can be "trained up in the way they should go" by experiencing a full service and we can give our volunteers a break each month too. The nursery rooms are going to get some updates in the coming weeks (please see Bobbi Galloway for details). We'll be restarting our youth group ministry for Grades 6 & up on Sunday, January 21st with a kick-off party at 6:30pm. We'll also be working on a 2024 church family photo directory, please be patient with us as we have a few other office tasks that take priority so this might actually not be ready until late in February.

One of the last changes I'll go over is a regular happening—the new officers for leadership. Included in this newsletter is a copy of the leadership list. Please be in prayer for these individuals as several are stepping into new roles in service to Christ and the Church. We'll share in prayer and blessing for these individuals during worship on Sunday, January 21st—if you are able to attend please come as I have always found this to be a special service at the congregations I have served.

Change is coming, it is something we will always have with us. Yet, even the bad changes that are so often in the headlines (and I avoided writing about) are an opportunity to speak the Good News into a lost and dying world. I pray that the many good changes we're experiencing will enable us to reach a lot of people with the Gospel in 2024.

Marion County Auditor Joan Kasotis announced this year's winners of her Top Dog essay contest. This year there were 24 entries. The essay contest was open to Marion County students currently in third through fifth grade. In 50 to 100 words, students were asked to explain why their dog is #1 or a friend's or neighbor's dog.

First place went to Alice Claborn, 9, a fourth grade student at Benjamin Harrison Elementary who wrote that she and her dog Mercy have something in common — they were both adopted. "Mercy and I grew up together," Alice wrote. "She comes to school with me every day. Mercy sleeps with me. Sometimes she brings me food like the time she buried a potato in the covers."



Second place honors went to Piper Croskey, 9, a fourth grader at Heritage Elementary. She says her dog Daisy is Top Dog because "she makes her feel better when I'm sad."

In third place was Alanna Powelson, 9, who is in third grade at Pleasant Elementary, who called her "pound puppy" Trixie "loyal, smart and funny."

The first place winner received the county's #1 dog tag valued at \$20. The second place prize was pet supplies valued at \$15 while the third place winner received a \$10 gift certificate.

This year's judges were Kasotis, Clerk of Court Jessica Wallace, Treasurer Jan Draper, Sheriff Matt Bayles, and Municipal Court Judge Teresa Ballinger. Kasotis reminds residents that 2024 dog tags are now on sale at the County Auditor's office, the Marion County Dog Pound as well as several satellite locations, including the Marion Public Library on Monday from 4:30-6:30 p.m.




