## **November Election Information**

## If Issue 1 passes:

- Erases parental notification & excludes parents from their child's medical decisions, such as abortion or irreversible sex-change operations.
- Would always allow an unborn child to be aborted at any stage of pregnancy, regardless of viability.
- The treating physician decides if the abortion is necessary to protect the pregnant woman's life or health, including mental, physical, financial, etc.
- Allows for-profit abortion providers, such as Planned Parenthood, to self-regulate & perform abortions up to viability & beyond at the sole discretion of the abortionist.
- Removes even basic limits on abortion.
   Allows dismemberment abortions;
   painful, late-term abortions & abortions
   after a child is born alive.
- Late term abortion would be enshrined in the Ohio Constitution forever.

## If Issue 2 passes...

- It legalizes an addiction-for– profit industry.
- It would legalize the processing, sale, purchase, possession, home grow and use of marijuana by adults who are 21 & older.
- Exposes kids to a mind-altering substance in kid-friendly forms, such as candy & cookies.
- Promotes recreational use of a drug that causes withdrawal, distorted perceptions, respiratory damage, anxiety, depression, suicidal thoughts & schizophrenia.
- Endangers others by driving under the influence.
- Heightens the risk of workplace injuries.
- Adds more government—the Division of Cannabis Control—within the Department of Commerce.
